

On scrutiny of applications it is found that in category 01 (64 No's), Category 02 (04 No's) of applications applicants has not submitted have failed to submit any proof regarding their claim i.e. they were neither petitioner for Category No-1 nor they have submitted any proof regarding encroachment on HSVP/ Govt. Land hence their applications are rejected by the Committee. Further in Category 4, 02 No's of applications were received from other States and they were also rejected as per terms & conditions of broucher and rest 190 No's of applications were received in category No. 3 & 4 (category No. 3-114 No's applications & category 4-76 No's applications).

As per preference No-1 of the Broucher 64 Nos. applicants applied in this category. The above mentioned 04 Nos of applicants has applied in Category No-2 but they have failed to submit any proof regarding there encroachment on HSVP/ Govt. Land. Hence the claims of applicants mentioned at



Sr. No. 1 to 04 cannot be considered and the same were rejected for allotment of Flat under Ashiana Scheme. (Details attached as Annexure-2)

As per preference No-3 of the Broucher 114 Nos. applicants applied in this category. That third preference for allotment of flat has to be given to applicants of Category No-3 i.e. who are in BPL category. The above mentioned 114 Nos of applicants has applied in BPL Category and 79 applicants have found eligible and 08 Nos applications reports are awaited and balance 27 Nos. application were found ineligible (Details attached as Annexure-3)

As per preference No-4 of the Broucher 78 Nos. applicants applied in this category. That fourth preference for allotment of flat has to be given to applicants of EWS Category. In this category Income Certificate has been checked as per above said scheme those applicant benefit can be given only their annual income come upto Rs. 3.00 Lacs or the income limit fixed by the competent authority from time to time.

In view of above the Committee has detailed discussion in this point, at the time of flotation EWS applicant annual income upto 3.00 Lacs or the income limit fixed by the competent authority from time to time. At present committee has not authorized to decide the annual income in this category at this stage. The Committee has decided that EWS decision/ Guideline regarding income limit be Committee has decided that EWS decision, Suideline regarding the competent sought from the Chief Administrator, HSVP, Panchkula or any other competent authority. Hence the committee decided to keep application under EWS category pending till the necessary guideline received from the Head Quarter.

The report of Committee is submitted to the Administrator, HSVP, Gurugram as well as the Chief Administrator, HSVP, Panchkula for further necessary action please.
